INTERNATIONAL CHILD ABDUCTION ACT (CHAPTER 143C)

INTERNATIONAL CHILD ABDUCTION (APPLICATION OF LEGISLATION RELATING TO LEGAL AID AND LEGAL ADVICE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the International Child Abduction Act, the Minister for Law makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the International Child Abduction (Application of Legislation relating to Legal Aid and Legal Advice) (Amendment) Regulations 2019 and come into operation on 31 May 2019.

Amendment of regulation 3

2. Regulation 3 of the International Child Abduction (Application of Legislation relating to Legal Aid and Legal Advice) Regulations 2011 (G.N. No. S 74/2011) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended by inserting, immediately after the words “Part I” in paragraph (a), the words “(except section 3(4)(b))”.

Amendment of regulation 4

3. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) subsections (1), (1A), (1B) and (4) of that section do not apply;”.
