**MEDICINES  
(PROHIBITION OF SALE AND SUPPLY)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2019**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Medicines Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Medicines (Prohibition of Sale and Supply) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 January 2020.

**Amendment of paragraph 1**

2. Paragraph 1 of the Medicines (Prohibition of Sale and Supply) Order (O 4) is amended by deleting the words “and Supply” and substituting the words “, Supply and Importation”.

**Amendment of paragraph 3**

3. Paragraph 3 of the Medicines (Prohibition of Sale and Supply) Order is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “No person shall sell or supply to any person” in sub-paragraph (1) and substituting the words “Subject to sub-paragraph (1A), a person must not sell or supply to any other person”;
- (b) by inserting, immediately after sub-paragraph (1), the following sub-paragraph:
  - “(1A) A person must not sell, supply or import any topical antiseptic that contains mercury or any compound of mercury.”; and
