### **ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)**

#### **ROAD TRAFFIC (EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 74) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Exemption from Section 74) (Amendment) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 February 2019.

#### **Amendment of paragraph 1**

2. Paragraph 1 of the Road Traffic (Exemption from Section 74) Order 2005 (G.N. No. S 410/2005) is amended by deleting the words “Exemption from Section 74” and substituting the words “Helmet Exemption”.

#### **Amendment of paragraph 2**

3. Paragraph 2 of the Road Traffic (Exemption from Section 74) Order 2005 is amended —

- (a) by inserting, immediately after the words “of the Act”, the words “and rule 14 of the Road Traffic (Bicycles) Rules (R 3)”; and
- (b) by inserting, immediately after the words “a motor cycle”, the words “, and when riding or being carried on a bicycle or a power-assisted bicycle on a road, respectively”.
