(AMENDMENT) NOTIFICATION 2018

**Variation of Responsibility of Minister for Trade and Industry
(Trade)**

It is notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, varied with effect from 1 April 2018, the Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Minister for Trade and Industry (Trade)) Notification 2015 (G.N. No. S 661/2015) —

- (a) by deleting item 1 under the heading “DEPARTMENTS AND STATUTORY BODIES” and substituting the following item:

“1. Competition and Consumer Commission of Singapore”;
and

- (b) by inserting, immediately after item 1 under the heading “SUBJECTS”, the following item:

“1A. Consumer Protection (Fair Trading)”.
