**IMMIGRATION ACT
(CHAPTER 133)**

**IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 55(1) of the Immigration Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations 2018 and come into operation on 1 October 2018.

Amendment of regulation 22A

2. Regulation 22A of the Immigration Regulations (Rg 1) is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “permit or a pass” in paragraph (1) and substituting the words “Singapore visa, pass or permit”;
- (b) by deleting sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:
 - “(a) a person who has been granted a Singapore visa, or issued with a pass or permit;”;and
- (c) by deleting the full-stop at the end of sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (2) and substituting a semi-colon, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following sub-paragraph:
 - “(d) a person (other than a citizen of Singapore) who transits through Singapore.”.
