**PRIVATE SECURITY INDUSTRY ACT  
(CHAPTER 250A)**

**PRIVATE SECURITY INDUSTRY  
(CONDUCT) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 39 of the Private Security Industry Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Private Security Industry (Conduct) (Amendment) Regulations 2018 and come into operation on 1 January 2019.

**New regulation 7A**

2. The Private Security Industry (Conduct) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 170/2009) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 7, the following regulation:

**“Conduct of licensed security officers on duty, etc.**

**7A.—**(1) When carrying out the functions as a security officer, a licensed security officer must —

- (a) not sleep;
- (b) not consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol;
- (c) not be absent from the place where the licensed security officer is deployed without any valid reason;
- (d) not use any threatening or abusive language; and
