**CENTRAL PROVIDENT FUND  
(RETIREMENT SUM TOPPING-UP SCHEME)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2017**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 77(1) of the Central Provident Fund Act, the Minister for Manpower, after consulting with the Central Provident Fund Board, makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Central Provident Fund (Retirement Sum Topping-Up Scheme) (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into operation on 1 July 2017.

**Amendment of regulation 10C**

2. Regulation 10C(1) of the Central Provident Fund (Retirement Sum Topping-Up Scheme) (Rg 3) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended by deleting “10D,”.

**Deletion and substitution of regulation 10D**

3. Regulation 10D of the principal Regulations is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

**“Additional payment from amount deposited with approved bank or retained in retirement account, where member attained age of 55 years before 1 January 1987**

**10D.—**(1) A member who is entitled to receive payment under regulation 10C(1) or (3) may apply to the Board, in such manner as the Board may require, to be paid an additional amount from the member’s balance —

(a) if the member is entitled to receive payment under regulation 10C(1), on the later of the following:
