PUBLIC ORDER ACT (CHAPTER 257A)

PUBLIC ORDER (ELECTION MEETINGS IN PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Public Order Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2017 and come into operation on 1 October 2017.

Amendment of regulation 3

2. Regulation 3 of the Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 486/2009) is amended by deleting the full-stop at the end of the definition of “polling day” and substituting a semi-colon, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following definition:

“ “special notice” means the special notice of intention to organise an event, required by section 6A of the Act.”.

New regulation 11

3. The Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009 are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 10, the following regulation:

“Special notice of election meeting

11.—(1) For the purposes of section 6A(1) of the Act, special notice of an election meeting must be given to the Commissioner
