In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

##### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Chauffeured Private Hire Cars — Exemption) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 20 June 2017.

##### **Definitions**

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —  
“chauffeured private hire car” means a motor car that —
  - (a) does not ply for hire on any road; and
  - (b) is hired, or made available for hire, under a contract (express or implied) for use as a whole with a driver for the purpose of conveying the hirer, and one or more passengers (if any), in that car;
