ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT (AMENDMENT OF SECOND SCHEDULE) **ORDER 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Allied Health Professions Act, the Minister for Health, after consultation with the Allied Health Professions Council, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Allied Health Professions Act (Amendment of Second Schedule) Order 2016 and comes into operation on 15 April 2016.

Amendment of Second Schedule

2. The Second Schedule to the Allied Health Professions Act is amended by inserting, immediately after item 3, the following items:

- (b) the development of an optimal radiation treatment plan; and
- (c) the safe administration of radiation treatment.
- 2. The acts or activities constituting radiation therapy include, but are not limited to the following:
- (a) reviewing clinical requests;
- (b) fabricating appropriate immobilisation devices;
- (c) conducting pretreatment simulation and treatment planning to facilitate radiation treatment;
- (d) administering radiation treatment or other actions as part of a care team, which include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - (i) carrying out the appropriate image
