**MEDICINES  
(EXPORT LICENCE FOR PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Medicines Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Medicines (Export Licence for Psychotropic Substances) (Amendment) Regulations 2016 and come into operation on 1 November 2016.

**Deletion and substitution of regulation 3**

2. Regulation 3 of the Medicines (Export Licence for Psychotropic Substances) Regulations (Rg 9) is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

**“Licence to export psychotropic substance**

3. A person must not export any consignment of —

- (a) a psychotropic substance; or
- (b) a medicinal product containing any psychotropic substance,

unless —

- (i) the person possesses a valid export licence for that consignment; and
- (ii) the export of that consignment is in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in the export licence.”.
