In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9, 29, 30 and 54 of the Medicines Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order is the Medicines (Revocation) Order 2016 and comes into operation on 1 November 2016.

**Revocation**

**2.** The following Orders are revoked:

- (a) Medicines (Contact Lens Substances) (Specification and Prohibition) Order (O 9);
- (b) Medicines (Exemption) Order (O 5);
- (c) Medicines (Exemption) (No. 2) Order (O 8);
- (d) Medicines (Exemption) (No. 3) Order (O 10);
- (e) Medicines (Exemption) (No. 4) Order (O 11);
- (f) Medicines (Exemption of Registered Pharmacy from Wholesale Dealer's Licence) Order (O 7);
- (g) Medicines (Oral Dental Gums) (Specification) Order (O 19);
- (h) Medicines (Orphan Drugs) (Exemption) Order (O 12);
