**ROAD TRAFFIC
(MOTOR VEHICLES, CONSTRUCTION AND USE)
(AMENDMENT) RULES 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Act, the Land Transport Authority of Singapore makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Construction and Use) (Amendment) Rules 2016 and come into operation on 1 January 2017.

New rule 24A

2. The Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Construction and Use) Rules (R 9) are amended by inserting, immediately after rule 24, the following rule:

“Height warning system

24A.—(1) Every vehicle must be fitted with a height warning system capable of giving audible and sufficient warning to the driver of the vehicle when the crane mounted on the vehicle is extended to a height which causes the overall height of the vehicle to exceed the stowed height of the vehicle.

(2) Every height warning system fitted to a vehicle must at all times while the vehicle is being driven on a road be in operation and maintained in good working order.

(3) A person must not modify or tamper with the working of a height warning system of a vehicle in a manner that is likely to
