In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

**Citation**

**1.** This Order is the Road Traffic (Volvo Diesel Hybrid Bus Trial) (Exemption) Order 2016.

**Definitions**

**2.** In this Order —

“bus service licence” means a bus service licence that is granted (or is deemed granted) under Part 3 of the Bus Services Industry Act 2015 (Act 30 of 2015);

“DHB” means the Volvo B5RH diesel hybrid bus which —

- (a) is distributed in Singapore by Volvo; and
- (b) is used by SBST or Volvo during the conduct of the Volvo Diesel Hybrid Bus Trial for the purposes of testing and developing the use of diesel hybrid technology in omnibus operations;
