**IMMIGRATION ACT
(CHAPTER 133)**

**IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 55(1) of the Immigration Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and come into operation on 1 April 2015.

Amendment of regulation 12

2. Regulation 12 of the Immigration Regulations (Rg 1) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after paragraph (1), the following paragraph:

“(1A) Despite paragraph (1), the Controller may issue a visit pass, valid for such period as the Controller may determine but in any event not exceeding 90 days, to a prohibited immigrant referred to in section 8(3)(ba) of the Act (in these Regulations called an exempt prohibited immigrant) where the exempt prohibited immigrant satisfies the Controller that he wishes to enter Singapore for any of the purposes referred to in that paragraph.”;

(b) by deleting the words “any person (other than a prohibited immigrant)” in paragraph (2) and substituting the words “an exempt prohibited immigrant or a person who is not any other prohibited immigrant”; and
