**IMMIGRATION
(EXEMPTION FROM SINGAPORE VISA)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 56 of the Immigration Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Exemption from Singapore Visa) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2015 and comes into operation on 2 January 2016.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. Paragraph 2 of the Immigration (Exemption from Singapore Visa) Order (O 4) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after sub-paragraph (gd) of sub-paragraph (1), the following sub-paragraph:

“(ge) a non-citizen —

(i) who —

(A) holds a valid diplomatic or service passport issued by the government of the foreign territory specified in Part IX of the Schedule; and

(B) is travelling to Singapore for an attendance not exceeding 90 days;

(ii) who —

(A) is a person appointed to work in a diplomatic mission or consular
