SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE ACT (CHAPTER 294)

SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE (TRADE EFFLUENT) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2015

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Sewerage and Drainage Act, the Public Utilities Board, with the approval of the Minister for the Environment and Water Resources, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sewerage and Drainage (Trade Effluent) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and shall come into operation on 13 February 2015.

Deletion and substitution of regulation 8

2. Regulation 8 of the Sewerage and Drainage (Trade Effluent) Regulations (Rg 5) (referred to in these Regulations as the principal Regulations) is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

“Nature and type of trade effluent to be discharged

8.—(1) A person must not discharge or caused to be discharged into any public sewer any trade effluent —

- (a) which is not of a nature or type approved by the Board;
- (b) the temperature of which exceeds 45° Celsius at the point of its entry into the public sewer;
- (c) the pH value of which is less than 6 or more than 9 at the point of its entry into the public sewer; or
- (d) the caustic alkalinity of which is more than 2,000 milligrams of calcium carbonate per litre at the point of its entry into the public sewer.
