**ROAD TRAFFIC  
(PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES)  
(VOCATIONAL LICENCES AND CONDUCT OF DRIVERS,  
CONDUCTORS, TRISHAW RIDERS AND PASSENGERS)  
(AMENDMENT) RULES 2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 111 of the Road Traffic Act, the Land Transport Authority of Singapore hereby makes the following Rules:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) (Vocational Licences and Conduct of Drivers, Conductors, Trishaw Riders and Passengers) (Amendment) Rules 2014 and shall come into operation on 1 January 2015.

**New rule 22A**

2. The Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) (Vocational Licences and Conduct of Drivers, Conductors, Trishaw Riders and Passengers) Rules (R 8) are amended by inserting, immediately after rule 22, the following rule:

**“Prohibition on soliciting or loitering to solicit passengers**

**22A.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person licensed to drive a specified vehicle shall not, in a public place —

- (a) loiter for the purpose of soliciting passengers, by any means, for any specified vehicle; or
- (b) solicit passengers, other than by means of advertisement, for any specified vehicle.
