# CENTRAL PROVIDENT FUND ACT (CHAPTER 36)

## CENTRAL PROVIDENT FUND (APPROVED MIDDLE-INCOME HOUSING SCHEME) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 77(1) of the Central Provident Fund Act, Mr Tan Chuan-Jin, Senior Minister of State, charged with the responsibility of the Minister for Manpower, after consulting with the Central Provident Fund Board, hereby makes the following Regulations:

### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Central Provident Fund (Approved Middle-Income Housing Scheme) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and shall come into operation on 15th December 2013.

## **New regulation 10C**

**2.** The Central Provident Fund (Approved Middle-Income Housing Scheme) Regulations (Rg 4) are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 10B, the following regulation:

## "Application for cancellation of charge on immovable property

- **10C.**—(1) For the purposes of sections 21(10A), 21A(9A) and 27E(2)(ii) of the Act, where there is a charge under section 21(1) or 21A(1) of the Act, as the case may be, on a member's estate or interest in an immovable property, the member may apply to the Board for the charge to be cancelled.
- (2) The Board may approve an application under paragraph (1) for the charge to be cancelled if the Board is satisfied that the member
  - (a) is entitled to withdraw the amount standing to his credit in the Fund under section 15(2)(a), (d), (e), (f) or (g), (3), (4), (7A) or (8) of the Act;
