# CENTRAL PROVIDENT FUND ACT (CHAPTER 36)

## CENTRAL PROVIDENT FUND (NON-RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES SCHEME) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 77(1) of the Central Provident Fund Act, Mr Tan Chuan-Jin, Senior Minister of State, charged with the responsibility of the Minister for Manpower, after consulting with the Central Provident Fund Board, hereby makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Central Provident Fund (Non-Residential Properties Scheme) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and shall come into operation on 15th December 2013.

## Deletion and substitution of regulation 22

**2.** Regulation 22 of the Central Provident Fund (Non-Residential Properties Scheme) Regulations (Rg 10) is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

## "Application for cancellation of charge on immovable property

- 22.—(1) For the purposes of sections 21(10A), 21A(9A) and 27E(2)(ii) of the Act, where there is a charge under section 21(1) or 21A(1) of the Act, as the case may be, on a member's estate or interest in an immovable property, the member may apply to the Board for the charge to be cancelled.
- (2) The Board may approve an application under paragraph (1) for the charge to be cancelled if the Board is satisfied that the member —
