MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT  
(AMENDMENT OF FIFTH SCHEDULE)  
ORDER 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 58A of the Misuse of Drugs Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Act (Amendment of Fifth Schedule) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on 2nd May 2013 2013.

**Amendment of Fifth Schedule**

2. The Fifth Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “Any compound containing a 3-(1-naphthoyl)insole structure with substitution at the nitrogen atom of the insole ring by an alkyl, halo alkyl, alchemy” in paragraph 1 and substituting the words “Any compound containing a 3-(1-naphthoyl)indole structure with substitution at the nitrogen atom of the indole ring by an alkyl, haloalkyl, alkenyl”; and
- (b) by deleting the item “2-Diphenylmethylpiperidine, also known as desoxypipradol” in paragraph 11 and substituting the item “2-Diphenylmethylpiperidine, also known as desoxypipradol”.
