ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR VEHICLES, REGISTRATION AND LICENSING) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) RULES 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 34 and 140 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Registration and Licensing) (Amendment No. 3) Rules 2013 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 7th March 2013.

Amendment of rule 25

2. Rule 25 of the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Registration and Licensing) Rules (R 5) is amended —

(a) by deleting sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (5) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(c) at the expiration of the 3-month period referred to in sub-paragraph (b), extend the period of registration of the vehicle in the name of the firm or company for a further period of 3 months upon the payment of —

(i) a fee of \$90, if the 3-month period referred to in sub-paragraph (b) expired on or after 25th May 2009 but before 24th February 2011; or
