**EMPLOYMENT OF FOREIGN MANPOWER
(BAIL AND PERSONAL BOND) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2012**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 29(2)(g) of the Employment of Foreign Manpower Act, Mr Tan Chuan-Jin, Senior Minister of State, charged with the responsibility of the Minister for Manpower, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment of Foreign Manpower (Bail and Personal Bond) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and shall come into operation on 9th November 2012.

Amendment of regulation 4

2. Regulation 4 of the Employment of Foreign Manpower (Bail and Personal Bond) Regulations (Rg 1) is amended —

(a) by deleting paragraph (4) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(4) Without prejudice to paragraph (3), it shall be a condition of the bond executed under paragraph (1) or (2) that the person released on bail or on personal bond —

- (a) shall surrender any travel document in his possession;
- (b) shall surrender to custody on the day and at the time and place appointed for him to do so;
- (c) shall attend on the day and at the time and place mentioned in the bond, or on such other day or at such other time and place as may be required by an employment inspector, and continue so to attend until otherwise directed by an employment inspector;
