ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46(2) of the Interpretation Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Interpretation (Remission of Singapore Visa Fees) (ICPO-INTERPOL) Order 2012 and shall come into operation on 3rd September 2012.

Remission of visa fee

- **2.**—(1) There shall be remitted all fees payable under paragraph 3 of the Interpretation (Singapore Visa Fees) Order 2007 (G.N. No. S 652/2007) by the following persons for their travel to and entry into Singapore for the purposes of their functions with or missions to the Complex:
 - (a) delegates from foreign sovereign Powers which are members of the ICPO-INTERPOL, and observers attending conferences or meetings convened by the ICPO-INTERPOL;
 - (b) members of the Executive Committee of the ICPO-INTERPOL;
