**TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS ACT  
(CHAPTER 333A)**

**TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS  
(REGISTRATION OF ACUPUNCTURISTS)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2012**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(4) of the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners Act, the Minister for Health hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners (Registration of Acupuncturists) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and shall come into operation on 1st April 2012.

**Amendment of regulation 4**

**2.** Regulation 4(2) of the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners (Registration of Acupuncturists) Regulations (Rg 1) (referred to in these Regulations as the principal Regulations) is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (g) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(g) the fee for the application for registration specified in the First Schedule; and”.

**Deletion of regulation 5**

**3.** Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is deleted.

**Deletion and substitution of First Schedule**

**4.** The First Schedule to the principal Regulations is deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor:
