In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Nanyang Technological University Power-Assisted Bicycles Trial) (Exemption from Part I and Section 91) Order 2011.

Definition

- 2.** In this Order, “power-assisted bicycle” means a bicycle —
- (a) that is equipped with an electric motor;
 - (b) that may be propelled by muscular power or by the electric motor with which it is equipped, or by both;
 - (c) which is assembled and used by Nanyang Technological University for the Nanyang Technological University Power-Assisted Bicycles Trial experiment; and
