In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Temporary Private Hire Cars) (Exemption) (No. 5) Order 2011.

**Exemption**

**2.** Section 101 of the Act shall not apply to a vehicle which bears any registration number set out in the Schedule and which —

- (a) is used as a private hire car between 4th October 2011 and 8th October 2011 (both dates inclusive) by the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry for the purpose of the event known as the World Chinese Entrepreneurs Convention 2011;
- (b) has valid insurance cover for its use as a private hire car when it is so used; and
- (c) displays a label issued by the Registrar in such manner as he may require.
