# DANGEROUS FIREWORKS ACT (CHAPTER 72)

DANGEROUS FIREWORKS (EXEMPTION) (NO. 3) NOTIFICATION 2009

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

## Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 3) Notification 2009.

## **Exemption**

2. Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a fireworks display executed by Glorious (S) Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

#### **EVENT**

1.	Name of Event:	Chingay F	Parade 2009.
2.	Places:	(a)	City Hall along St Andrew's Road
		(b)	Raffles Avenue (in front of Powerhouse).
3.	Dates and Times:	30th January 2009 between 6 p.m. and 11.59 p.m. (Preview) 31st January 2009 between 6 p.m. and 11.59 p.m. (Actual).	

#### PART II

## **CONDITIONS**

- 1. The fireworks display shall be limited to the following types of fireworks:
  - (a) multiple shots;
  - (b) roman candles;
  - (c) comets;
  - (d) mines;
  - (e) concussions;
  - (f) theatrical flash;
  - (g) firecrackers;
  - (h) saxon wheels;
  - (i) gerbs;
  - (j) fountains; and
  - (k) coloured stars.
- 2. In the fireworks display, no fireworks shall be discharged unless they have been certified safe and approved by
  - (a) the competent authority of the country of origin or manufacture; and
  - (b) the manufacturer of the fireworks.
  - 3. In the fireworks display, no fireworks shall be discharged where the period of recommended usage
