**CHARITIES ACT
(CHAPTER 37)**

**CHARITIES (FUND-RAISING APPEALS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2008**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 48 of the Charities Act, the Minister for Community Development, Youth and Sports hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Charities (Fund-Raising Appeals) (Amendment) Regulations 2008 and shall come into operation on 1st April 2008.

Amendment of regulation 7

2. Regulation 7 of the Charities (Fund-Raising Appeals) Regulations 2007 (G.N. No. S 176/2007) is amended by deleting paragraph (1) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(1) The total relevant fund-raising expenses of a charity for the financial year ending on or after 1st April 2008, and for every subsequent financial year, shall not exceed 30% of the total relevant receipts from fund-raising and sponsorships for that financial year, as determined by the following formula:

$$\frac{(E + S)}{(R + S)} \times 100\% \leq 30\%$$

where E refers to the total expenses relating to fund-raising for the financial year, including —

- (a) direct and material indirect expenses of any kind; and
