## **MEDICAL REGISTRATION ACT (CHAPTER 174)**

### **MEDICAL REGISTRATION ACT (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) (NO. 2) ORDER 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 71 of the Medical Registration Act, the Minister for Health, after consultation with the Singapore Medical Council, hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Medical Registration Act (Amendment of Schedule) (No. 2) Order 2006 and shall come into operation on 1st August 2006.

#### **Amendment of Schedule**

**2.** The Schedule to the Medical Registration Act is amended —

- (a)* by deleting “MBBS” under the heading “*Primary Qualifications*” in items 1 to 4 and 6 to 10 relating to the country “Australia” and substituting in each case “MB BS”;
- (b)* by inserting, immediately after item 7 relating to the country “Canada”, the following items:

8. Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry, University of MD  
Alberta

9. Faculté de Médecine, Université de Montréal MD

10. College of Medicine, MD  
University of Saskatchewan

”;

- (c) by deleting “MBBS” under the heading “*Primary Qualifications*” in item 2 relating to the country “Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, Peoples’ Republic of China” and substituting “MB BS”;
- (d) by inserting, immediately after the country “Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, Peoples’ Republic of China” and the entries relating thereto, the following country and entries:

India 1. All-India Institute of Medical MB BS  
Sciences

2. Christian Medical College, MB BS  
Vellore

”;

- (e) by inserting, immediately after the country “Ireland” and the entries relating thereto, the following country and entries:

“

Israel 1. Faculty of Medicine, MD  
The Hebrew University of Jerusalem

2. Sackler Faculty of Medicine, MD  
Tel Aviv University

”;

- (f) by deleting the country “Japan” and the entries relating thereto and substituting the following country and entries:

“

Japan 1. University of Tokyo Igakushi  
(Bachelor of Medicine)
