**MISCELLANEOUS OFFENCES (PUBLIC ORDER AND NUISANCE) (ELECTION  
MEETINGS — COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) RULES 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 (1) of the Miscellaneous Offences (Public Order and Nuisance) Act, read with section 199A of the Criminal Procedure Code (Cap. 68), the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Rules:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Rules may be cited as the Miscellaneous Offences (Public Order and Nuisance) (Election Meetings — Composition of Offences) Rules 2006 and shall come into operation on 21st April 2006.

**Compoundable offences**

**2.—(1)** The following offences under the Miscellaneous Offences (Public Order and Nuisance) (Election Meetings) Rules 2006 (G.N. No. S 236/2006) may be compounded by the Commissioner of Police in accordance with section 199A of the Criminal Procedure Code:

(a) any offence under rule 3(2) for contravening any condition of an election
