HOUSE TO HOUSE AND STREET COLLECTIONS (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) REGULATIONS 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the House to House and Street Collections Act, read with section 199A of the Criminal Procedure Code (Cap. 68), the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the House to House and Street Collections (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2005 and shall come into operation on 14th October 2005.

Compoundable offences

2.—(1) The following offences may be compounded by the Commissioner of Police in accordance with section 199A of the Criminal Procedure Code:

- (a) an offence under section 7 of the Act; and
- (b) an offence under section 5(3) of the Act in relation to the contravention of
