DANGEROUS FIREWORKS (EXEMPTION) (NO. 7) NOTIFICATION 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 7) Notification 2004.

Exemption

2. Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a fireworks display executed by Glorious Singapore Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

CONDITIONS

1. The fireworks display shall be limited to the following types of fireworks:
 - (a) concussions;
 - (b) smoke cartridges;
 - (c) theatrical flashes;
 - (d) lances;
 - (e) line rockets;
 - (f) gerbs;
 - (g) fountains;
 - (h) waterfall;
 - (i) saxon wheels;
 - (j) multiple shot;
