TRADE MARKS (EXCLUDED DAY) RULES 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 78 and 108 of the Trade Marks Act, the Minister for Law, after consultation with the Intellectual Property Office of Singapore, hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Trade Marks (Excluded Day) Rules 2002.

Excluded day

2. In addition to the excluded days set out in rule 80 of the Trade Marks Rules (R 1), 11th February 2002 shall be an excluded day for all purposes under the Act and the Trade Marks Rules except for —

- (a) any inspection of the register under section 68 of the Act;
- (b) the making of any application for registration of a trade mark, not being an application filed through the electronic online system and not being an application in which a claim for a right of priority under section 10 or 11 of
