# FACTORIES ACT (CHAPTER 104)

## FACTORIES (SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM) ORDER 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 71B(1) of the Factories Act, the Minister for Manpower hereby makes the following Order:

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Factories (Safety Management System) Order 2000 and shall come into operation on 1st March 2001.

# Classes of factories to which section 71B of Act applies

- **2.** Section 71B of the Act shall apply to the following classes or descriptions of factories:
  - (a) factories engaged in the processing or manufacturing of petroleum, petroleum products, petrochemicals or petrochemical products;
  - (b) factories engaged in the manufacture of semiconductor wafers; and
  - (c) factories engaged in the manufacture of fabricated metal products, machinery or equipment and in which 100 or more persons are employed.
