ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

POLICE OFFICERS TO EXERCISE POWERS OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF POLICE

It is hereby notified for general information that, in exercise of the powers conferred by the definition of “Deputy Commissioner of Police” in section 2(1) of the Road Traffic Act, the Deputy Commissioner of Police has authorised, with effect from 25th September 2000 —

- (a) the Field Officers of the Traffic Police Department to exercise the powers vested in the Deputy Commissioner of Police by section 85 of the Act; and
- (b) the following police officers of the Traffic Police Department to exercise the powers vested in the Deputy Commissioner of Police by sections 85, 87, 94, 95 and 123 of the Act or by any rules made under section 123:
 - (i) the Commander, the Head (Operations) and the Head (Administration);
 - (ii) the Head (Traffic Investigation), the Deputy Head (Traffic Investigation), the Chief Investigation Officers and the Investigation Officers;
 - (iii) the Officer-in-Charge Violation Reports and the Violation Reports Officers; and
