## **PRIVATE HOSPITALS AND MEDICAL CLINICS ACT (CHAPTER 248)**

## **PRIVATE HOSPITALS AND MEDICAL CLINICS (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) REGULATIONS 2000**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 22 of the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act, the Minister for Health hereby makes the following Regulations:

### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2000 and shall come into operation on 10th August 2000.

### **Compoundable offences**

**2.** The following offences may be compounded by the Director in accordance with section 20(1) of the Act:

- (a) any offence under section 5, 7, 12 or 14(1) or (2) of the Act; and
- (b) any offence under regulation 55 of the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Regulations (Rg 1) in connection with any contravention or failure
