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In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Fees Act, the Minister for Finance hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Fees (Trade Marks Act — Border Enforcement Measures) Order 1999 and shall come into operation on 26th January 1999.

**Definitions**

**2.** In this Order —

“authorised officer” and “Director-General” have the same meanings respectively as in section 81 of the Trade Marks Act 1998 (Act 46/98);

“conveyance” has the same meaning as in the Regulation of Imports and Exports Act (Cap. 272A);

“seized goods” means goods which were seized by an authorised officer under section 82 of the Trade Marks Act 1998.
