CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SENIOR MINISTER, PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE) NOTIFICATION 1997

Responsibility of Senior Minister, Prime Minister's Office

It is hereby notified for general information that in pursuance of Article 30 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister has directed that Mr Lee Kuan Yew shall, with effect from 25th January 1997, be charged with responsibility for advising Ministers on any of the subjects under their charge and that he shall be designated as Senior Minister, Prime Minister's Office.
