MEAT PROCESSING FACTORIES (CONTROL AND LICENSING) (AMENDMENT) RULES 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Slaughter-houses and Meat Processing Factories Act, the Minister for National Development hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Meat Processing Factories (Control and Licensing) (Amendment) Rules 1997 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1997.

Amendment of rule 7

2. Rule 7(a) of the Meat Processing Factories (Control and Licensing) Rules (R 2) is amended by deleting "\$180" in sub-paragraph (i) and "\$540" in sub-paragraph (ii) and substituting "\$200" and "\$600", respectively.
