TOWN COUNCILS (USE OF COMMON PROPERTY) RULES 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 19(1)(c) and 52 of the Town Councils Act, the Minister for National Development hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Town Councils (Use of Common Property) Rules 1997 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1997.

Charges

- **2.** A Town Council may impose charges only for the following uses of the following parts of common property in its Town:
 - (1) Commercial Operations
 - (a) Installation of telecommunications equipment on roof tops.
 - (b) Setting up temporary site offices and temporary stores in void decks and open spaces.
 - (c) Display of advertisements, banners or signs on any common property with or without the erection of any awnings.
