In exercise of the powers conferred by section 137A(6) of the Criminal Procedure Code, the Minister for Law hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Procedure (Pleading Guilty by Electronic Means) Regulations 1996 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1996.
