**HOLIDAYS ACT
(CHAPTER 126)**

(Original Enactment: Act 8 of 1998)

An Act relating to the observance of public holidays in Singapore.

[10th April 1998]

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Holidays Act.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

“public authority” means any board or authority established by or under any written law to perform or discharge any public function;

“public holiday” means —

- (a) any of the days specified in the Schedule; or
- (b) any other day declared by section 4(2) or under section 5 to be a public holiday.

Application of Act to Government

3. This Act binds the Government.

General public holidays

4.—(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the days specified in the Schedule are declared to be public holidays in Singapore.

(2) Subject to the provisions of this Act, if any day specified in the Schedule falls on a Sunday, the day next following not being itself a public holiday is declared a public holiday in Singapore.

Other public holidays

5.—(1) The President may, by notification in the *Gazette*, declare any day in any particular year to be observed as a public holiday in Singapore in addition to, or in substitution for, any day specified in the Schedule.

(2) Where in any year 2 public holidays fall on the same day, the President may, by notification in the *Gazette*, declare any day in that year to be observed as an additional public holiday.
