1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Profession (Fees for Ad Hoc Admission) Rules.

Fees to be paid for ad hoc admission

- **2.** Any person applying to be admitted under section 21 of the Act to practise as an advocate and solicitor shall pay under section 21(5)
 - (a) a fee of \$1,000 to the Law Society of Singapore; and
 - (b) a fee of \$1,000 to the Attorney-General,

for their costs incurred in the application.
