Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Licensing and Classification) Regulations.

Definitions

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —

“distribution point” means a place from which films are distributed;

“exhibition point” means any place where films are exhibited and includes a cinema multiplex with one or more exhibition halls.

Fees

3. The fee specified in the second column of the Schedule shall be payable for a licence granted under section 7 of the Act in respect of the matters set out in the first column thereof.

Waiver or reduction of fee

4. The Licensing Officer may, in his discretion and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit, waive or reduce any fee payable under these Regulations in any particular case or class of cases.

Temporary distribution points

5. In granting a licence under section 7 of the Act for a business for the temporary distribution of films, the Licensing Officer may impose as a condition of the licence that the temporary distribution of films may only be carried out at such designated distribution point or points as the Licensing Officer may specify.

Applicant to give cash deposit or bank guarantee

6.—(1) The Licensing Officer may, before granting a licence under section 7 of the Act, require the applicant to give security, in the form of a cash deposit or bank guarantee, of not more than \$30,000.

(2) The Licensing Officer may, before granting a licence for any business for the temporary distribution of films, require the applicant to give security, in the form of a cash deposit or bank guarantee, of \$5,000.

(3) The Licensing Officer may, before granting a licence for any business for the temporary exhibition of films, require the applicant to give security, in the form of a cash
