Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Children and Young Persons (Advisory Board) Regulations.

Definitions

- 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires
 - "advisory board" means an advisory board appointed under section 73(3) of the Act;
 - "home" means an approved home appointed or established under Part VI of the Act;
 - "resident" means any child or young person for the time being detained under the Act in a school or home;
 - "school" means an approved school appointed or established under Part VI of the Act;
 - "superintendent" means the superintendent in charge of and having the management and control of any school or home and includes any person appointed by the Director to exercise the duties of the superintendent in his absence.

Constitution of advisory board

- **3.**—(1) Every advisory board shall consist of
 - (*a*) a Chairman;

(b) a Vice-Chairman; and

(c) such number of other members as the Minister may think fit to appoint.

(2) At least one of the members of every advisory board shall be a nominee of the Director.

(3) The Minister may at any time revoke the appointment of any member of an advisory board.

Chairman

4.—(1) The Chairman of an advisory board shall be appointed by the Minister from amongst the members of the advisory board.

(2) The Chairman of an advisory board shall preside at all meetings of the advisory board.

Vice-Chairman

5.—(1) The Vice-Chairman of an advisory board shall be elected by the advisory board from amongst its members.

(2) In the absence of the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman of an advisory board shall preside at all meetings of the advisory board and shall have and may exercise all the powers and functions of the Chairman.

Secretary

6. The Director shall appoint a Secretary to each advisory board, except that the person appointed shall not —

- (a) be a member of the advisory board; or
- (b) vote at any proceedings of the advisory board.

Term of office of advisory board member

7.—(1) Each member of an advisory board shall hold office for a period of not more than two years from the date of his appointment and shall be eligible for re-appointment on completion of that period unless —

- (a) he resigns during his term of office; or
- (b) his appointment is revoked by the Minister under regulation 3(3).

(2) Any member of an advisory board may resign from his appointment at any time by giving notice in writing to the Minister.
