Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Children and Young Persons (Board of Visitors) Regulations.

Definitions

- 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires
 - "board of visitors" means a board of visitors appointed under section 65(1) of the Act;
 - "resident" means any child or young person for the time being detained under the Act in a remand home, place of detention, approved home, approved school or place of safety.

Constitution of board of visitors

- **3.**—(1) Every board of visitors shall consist of
 - (a) a Chairman;
 - (b) a Vice-Chairman; and
 - (c) such number of other members as the Minister may think fit to appoint.
- (2) At least one of the members of every board of visitors shall be a nominee of the Director.
- (3) The Minister may at any time revoke the appointment of any member of a board of visitors.

4.—(1) The Chairman of a board of visitors shall be appointed by the Minister from
