1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential (Emergency Service) (Regular Armed Forces) Regulations.

Continuance in service during the emergency

2. During the continuance in force of the Proclamation of Emergency issued by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong under Article 150 of the Constitution of Malaysia, every serviceman of the regular armed forces, who would but for these Regulations fall to be discharged or to be transferred to the reserve and any person in the reserves of the regular armed forces who has been or who may hereafter be called out for service by Proclamation or Order of the President under the provisions of any written law governing
