The Minister for Home Affairs has declared the games, methods, devices, schemes or competitions set out in the Schedule to be lotteries for the purposes of the Act.

THE SCHEDULE

- (a) The “100 characters” “1,000 characters” or “10,000 characters” game also known as the “100 numbers” “1,000 numbers” or “10,000 numbers” game also known as the “two-digit” “three-digit” or “four-digit” game also known as the “two-number”, “three number” or “four-number” game also known as the Tikam Ekor game or any variation thereof.
- (b) The *Chap Ji Kee* or “12 characters” game.
- (c) The *Wha Whey* or *Wah Weh*.
- (d) The *Whei Sang* or *Wai Seng*.
