Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Exemptions) (Consolidation) Order.

Exemptions

2. The exemptions set out in the first column of the Schedule are made under section 142 of the Act in respect of the provisions of the Act set out respectively in the second column of the Schedule.

carriage of passengers for reward under the Supplementary Public Transport Service Schemes in accordance with the terms and conditions of a permit issued by the Registrar whilst they are used for the purposes of the Supplementary Public Transport Service Schemes.

Motor vehicles which are not used in the course of business for hire or for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward on those occasions when such motor vehicles are used for the purposes of the carriage of passengers where payments are made by the passengers merely as a contribution towards the running expenses of such motor vehicles.

1. An applicant for a driving licence in respect of a Class 4A vehicle who has attained the age of 20 years but has not attained the age of 21 years subject to such conditions as the Minister may think fit to impose.

2. For the purpose of this paragraph, a Class 4A vehicle means an omnibus, that is to say, a public service vehicle which is used on scheduled services and in which passengers are charged separate and distinct fares.
